The *German-Japanese Society in the Aachen region* was founded in 2004.

The society supports exchange between Japan and Germany. It provides help to Japanese as well as to all citizens living in the Aachen region who want to inform themselves or build up contacts with Japan.

The society is mainly active in the areas of science and business.

An example of the activities is the support of Japanese guest scientists and their families who come to live and work in Aachen.

By organizing roadshows, the society wants to encourage students in Aachen to study at Japanese universities and to take part in exchange programs. Meetings between students, professors and guest scientists help students and young scientists to inform themselves about life in Japan.

In addition, the society gives general information about Japan such as cultural characteristics and mannerisms that are different in both countries.

Talks and discussions are regularly organized. These events should encourage companies to invest in Japan. By establishing contacts and supporting Japanese citizens, the society also tries to encourage Japanese companies to invest in Aachen.

To achieve the goals of the society, which are specified in the statutes (*Satzung*), the society needs active members and would be pleased to receive your support.
